## Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinic Subsidy Scale

When you receive services from our Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinic, you are responsible for payment for those services. If you are not able to pay, services will be available to you and we will assist you in exploring financial assistance. If you are eligible for assistance, all or part of your services may be paid for based on your household income (see scale below). Example, if you are a family of 4 with a household income of less than \$2,961 a month, you will be at a 0% fee. During your first appointment staff will review this information with you so it is clear what your cost, if any, would be for services.
